

You will need:

- Cereal box
- Paint or markers
- Black and white yarn
- 1 black pipe cleaner
- 2 wiggly eyes
- Scissors
- Glue or glue dots

Optional: construction paper



Directions:

1. Cut cereal box in half.



Step 1

2. Open up the boxes.



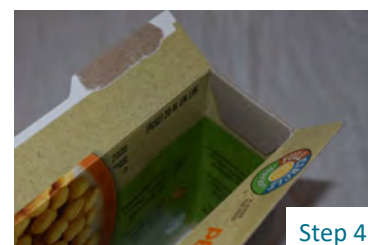
Step 2

3. Take one of the halves and glue it back together inside out so the shiny side is now on the inside (non-shiny side much easier to paint/color).



Step 3

4. Glue the 2 small side flaps inside the box.

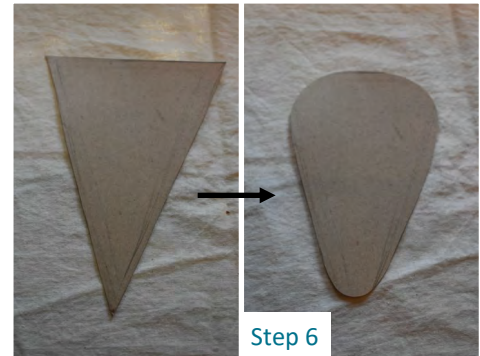


Step 4

- Cut 2 arcs out of the bottom flaps to make the legs of your hog.



- With the other half of the box cut out a large triangle (about 4" x 7") then round of the corners to make the head.



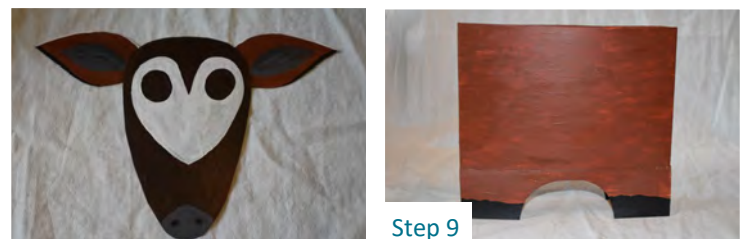
- Cut out the ears (Hint: draw one ear out on to the cardboard and cut it out; flip it over shiny side up and trace on to cardboard and cut out so now you will have opposite side ears on the cardboard side).



- Glue ears onto the back of the head.



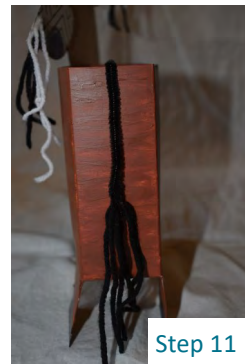
- Paint/color head and body (can also use colored construction paper to color the head and body).



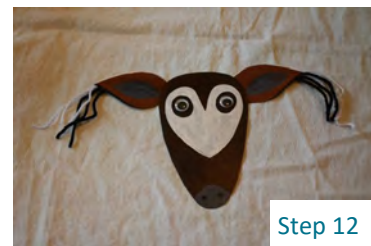
- Make the tail by cutting the pipe cleaner in half and wrapping one end around the middle of 3 pieces of 6-8" long black yarn (Hint: if you don't have pipe cleaners, you can either glue yarn on the back, use construction paper strips or use a painted straw).



11. Hook the other end of the pipe cleaner tail to one end of the body of the hog.



12. Glue on eyes then glue 3 black and 3 white 3-4" pieces of yarn to the back of each ear.



13. Glue the head on to the body and enjoy!!!
